WARSAW, MARCH 6 (UPI) - NOTICES APPEARING ON WARSAW UNIVERSITY BULLETIN BOARDS HAVE CONDEMNED A RECENT SPURT OF ANTI-SEMITIC PROPAGANDA CIRCULATED AT THE UNIVERSITY.

NOTICES OF THE ZMS (SOCIALIST YOUTH UNION) AND ZMW (PEASANTS YOUTH UNION) SAID "PROVOCATIVE ANTI-SEMITIC TEXTS," VERSES AND SOME LETTERS WERE MAILED TO STUDENT LEADERS AND LECTURERS.

THE NOTICES CALLED FOR SEVERE PUNISHMENT FOR THE ANONYMOUS AUTHORS, "REGARDLESS OF WHO MADE THE LEAFLETS AND IN WHOSE INTEREST,"

ONE NOTICE SAID SOME OF THE LETTERS WERE SIGNED WITH THE NAME "ROMAN DMOWSKI", WHO WAS A NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY LEADER BEFORE THE WAR. HE DIED IN 1939.

ANOTHER NOTICE SAID THEY WERE SIGNED BY A "BARBARA GOLDMACHER," A GERMAN JEWISH NAME.

NEITHER NOTICE GAVE ANY DETAILS ON THE LEAFLETS.
