WARSAW, MARCH 15 (UPI) <sup>Reuter</sup> -- WARSAW UNIVERSITY STUDENTS TODAY VOTED AT A MASS MEETING TO BOYCOTT CLASSES UNTIL MONDAY TO PRESS THEIR DEMANDS UPON THE AUTHORITIES FOR INFORMATION ABOUT POLICE ACTION IN LAST WEEK'S DEMONSTRATIONS.

THE BOYCOTT AT THE UNIVERSITY WAS TO BE FOLLOWED BY ANOTHER STUDENT MEETING MONDAY TO WHICH AN AS YET UNIDENTIFIED MEMBER OF THE PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAS BEEN INVITED. INFORMED SOURCES SAID THE PARTY REPRESENTATIVE WILL BE ASKED TO EXPLAIN WHAT THE PARTY INTENDS TO DO TO ANSWER STUDENTS COMPLAINTS.

ABOUT 2,000 STUDENTS AND A NUMBER OF PROFESSORS ATTENDED TODAY'S MEETING, THE SOURCES SAID.

THE DEMANDS MADE BY THE STUDENTS CAME IN A SEVEN-POINT RESOLUTION PASSED AT A MEETING LAST MONDAY. THE STUDENTS SEEK INFORMATION ON WHO CALLED THE POLICE INTO WARSAW UNIVERSITY GROUNDS MARCH 8 TO QUELL AN UNAUTHORIZED STUDENT DEMONSTRATION.

THE RESOLUTION ALSO DEMANDED THAT A LIST OF THE STUDENTS ARRESTED BE MADE PUBLIC, THAT PEOPLE BE TOLD WHO AUTHORIZED "SLANDEROUS" PRESS REPORTS ON THE STUDENT DEMONSTRATIONS, AND THAT CHANGES BE MADE IN THE DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION.

FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE RIOTS BROKE OUT LAST FRIDAY, THE RECTOR OF THE UNIVERSITY, STANISLAW TURSKI, MET WITH THE STUDENTS AT TODAY'S MASS MEETING.

THE SOURCES SAID HE TOLD THEM HE "COULD NOT AGREE" WITH STUDENT EXCESSES AND DESCRIBED THE STUDENTS RESOLUTIONS AS "BITS OF PAPER WITHOUT VALUE."

THE CALL FOR A WARSAW BOYCOTT OF CLASSES FOLLOWS  
BY A DAY SIMILAR ACTION IN THE ANCIENT POLISH CAPITAL  
AT KRAKOW IN THE SOUTHERN POLAND.

THE JAGELLONIAN UNIVERSITY AND THE POLYTECHNIC IN  
KRAKOW WERE DESERTED FOR THE SECOND DAY, WESTERN SOURCES  
SAID, WITH STUDENTS MEETING IN THE UNIVERSITY STUDENT  
CLUB.

SOURCES IN BOTH KRAKOW AND POZNAN, CENTRAL POLAND,  
HOWEVER, DESCRIBED LIFE AS "NORMAL" FOLLOWING CLASHES BETWEEN  
STUDENTS AND POLICE A FEW DAYS AGO.

THE RECTOR AND FACULTY OF WARSAW'S POLYTECHNIC WERE MEETING  
LATER TODAY TO DISCUSS A 15-POINT RESOLUTION FROM THEIR  
STUDENT BODY. AN ANSWER TO THE STUDENTS WAS EXPECTED  
TO BE GIVEN SATURDAY.

A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE POLYTECHNIC AT THE WARSAW UNIVERSITY  
MEETING TODAY SAID HE HAD BEEN TOLD THAT THE POLYTECHNIC  
STUDENTS, RESOLUTION HAD BEEN SENT BY THE RECTOR, UNSIGNED,  
TO COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER WLADYSLAW GOMULKA.

(RFE SPECIAL/ BERLIN) POLISH TELEVISION TONIGHT SHOWED PICTURES OF A STUDENT DEMONSTRATION WHICH IT SAID TOOK PLACE IN STETTIN <sup>14.3</sup> YESTERDAY.

THE TELECAST, SHOWN AT 1815 OVER THE STETTIN LOCAL STATION, SHOWED POLICE DISPERSING THE DEMONSTRATORS. THE COMMENTATOR SAID THE DEMONSTRATORS WERE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND NOT RPT NOT UNIVERSITY AGE.

HE APPEALED TO THE PARENTS OF STETTIN TO KEEP THEIR CHILDREN OFF THE STREETS AFTER 2000 AND SAID THAT EMERGENCY COURTS WERE BEING ESTABLISHED TO DEAL WITH OFFENDERS. IN SUCH CASES, THE COMMENTATORS SAID, THE SENTENCES WOULD BE DELIVERED SWIFTLY AND THE PUNISHMENTS COULD BE EXPECTED TO BE MORE SEVERE THAN UNDER ORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES.

(UPI) THE POLISH PRESS AND NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, MEANWHILE, ADDED "UNIVERSITY PROFESSORS" TO THOSE THEY ARE ATTACKING AS INSTIGATORS OF THE STUDENT UNREST.

WHILE CONTINUING THE ATTACK AGAINST THE "ZIONISTS AND OLD STALINISTS," THE POLISH VETERANS UNION (ZBOWID) DEMANDED THE REMOVAL OF PROFESSORS AND EDUCATORS "WHO HAVE NOT MET THE CONFIDENCE OF THE COMMUNITY AND WHO EXPLOITED THEIR NOBLE FUNCTIONS TO INJECT STUDENTS WITH HARMFUL THEORIES AND VIEWS.

STANISLAW MAJKOWSKI, CHAIRMAN OF THE POLISH JOURNALISTS ASSOCIATION, TOLD THE SEVENTH CONGRESS OF JOURNALISTS SOME EDUCATION WORKERS HAVE "BECOME CARRIERS OF VIEWS ALIEN TO SOCIALISM AND OF LIBERAL-BOURGEOIS THEORIES."

IT WAS ALSO REPORTED TODAY THAT FIVE CATHOLIC DEPUTIES TO PARLIAMENT LAST <sup>4.3.68</sup> MONDAY SENT A LETTER TO PREMIER JOZEF YRANKIEWICZ DEMANDING TO KNOW WHAT THE GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO DO TO STOP THE "BRUTAL ACTION" OF THE POLICY AND THE CIVILIAN AUXILIARY AGAINST STUDENTS AND WHO WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTION.

THE LETTER ALSO ASKED WHAT THE GOVERNMENT PLANNED TO DO TO ANSWER "THE BURNING QUESTIONS WHICH ALSO INCITE PUBLIC OPINION AND WHICH CONCERN THE FREEDOM OF CITIZENS AS WELL AS THE CULTURAL POLICY."

THE DEPUTIES, IDENTIFIED AS TADEUSZ MAZOWIECKI, STANISLAW STOMMA, JANUSZ ZABLOCKI, JERZY ZAWIEYSKI AND KONSTANTY LUBIENSKI, SAID THE POLICE INTERVENTION "AGGRAVATED THE SITUATION." THEY CALLED FOR "AN EXCHANGE OF VIEWS WITH SOCIETY."

(CMD) THE POLISH JOURNALISTS' ASSOCIATION TODAY ASSURED PARTY LEADER WLADYSLAW GOMULKA OF ITS FULL SUPPORT AND SAID IT CUT ITSELF OFF "DETERMINEDLY FROM ALL HOSTILE, ANTI-SOCIALIST AND ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES."

THE POLISH NEWS AGENCY PAP SAID THE PLEDGE CAME IN A LETTER TO GOMULKA ADOPTED BY THE JOURNALISTS AS THEY ENDED THEIR TWO-DAY CONVENTION.

THE LETTER BLASTED SO-CALLED POLITICAL BANKRUPTS "WHO DID NOT RPT NOT HESITATE EVEN TO ATTEMPT TO INCITE A PART OF ACADEMIC YOUTH AGAINST THE PEOPLES POWER."

(REUTER) A TELEVISION BROADCAST OF WORKERS PROTESTING IN KARAKOW AGAINST THE STUDENT DEMONSTRATIONS SHOWED ONE PARTICIPANT CARRYING A PLACARD SAYING "ZINONISTS - GO TO DAYAN AND ESHKOL".

YESTERDAYS KRAKOW NEWSPAPERS REACHING WARSAW TODAY SAID ABOUT 20 STUDENTS AND MILITIA WERE INJURED ON WEDNESDAY AND 24 STUDENTS ARRESTED.

A LUBLIN NEWSPAPER, SZTANDAR LUDU, REPORTED THAT 14 STUDENTS HAD BEEN SUSPENDED FOR TAKING PART IN DISTURBANCES LAST MONDAY IN THAT EAST POLISH TOWN.

IN POZNAN, WEST POLAND, NEWSPAPERS SAID THE MILITIA ARRESTED 84 PEOPLE DURING DEMONSTRATIONS LAST TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY. ALL BUT 14 HAD BEEN FREED.

WARSAW MILITIA HEADQUARTERS ANNOUNCED THAT 56 MORE PEOPLE HAD BEEN RELEASED FROM DETENTION IN THE CAPITAL.
