X/9 P - FOUR STUDENTS SENTENCED AND JAILED, FIVE HELD (SUPERSEDES CN 40)

WARSAW, MARCH 11 (AGENCIES/CMD) - POLISH NEWSPAPERS REVEALED TODAY THAT AT LEAST FOUR PERSONS WERE SENTENCED TO JAIL TERMS FOR THEIR PART IN LAST WEEK'S CLASHES BETWEEN POLICE AND STUDENTS.

THE SOCIALIST YOUTH NEWSPAPER SZTANDAR MLODYCH SAID OF NINE STUDENTS PICKED UP BY POLICE, THREE WERE JAILED FOR SIX MONTHS AND ONE FOR FOUR MONTHS FOR INSULTING STATE AUTHORITIES. FIVE OTHERS WERE BEING HELD FOR INVESTIGATION, THEY SAID.

THE PARTY NEWSPAPER TRYBUNA LUDU SAID THAT "A FEW SCORE" OF PERSONS WERE SENTENCED TO DETENTION OR FINES BY THE COURTS. IT SAID HALF OF THEM WERE NOT CONNECTED WITH THE UNIVERSITY.

IT DESCRIBED THE RINGLEADERS AS "HOTHEADED TROUBLEMAKERS" WHO HAD BEEN ACTIVE AT THE UNIVERSITY FOR SOME TIME.

TRYBUNA LUDU COMMENTED: "IT IS ASTONISHING THAT CHILDREN OF PARENTS OCCUPYING OFTEN RESPONSIBLE STATE AND SOCIAL POSITIONS TOOK PART IN THOSE BRAWLS."

THE NEWSPAPER SLOWO POWSZECHNE SAID "ZIONISTS IN POLAND WANT TO TURN INTELLECTUALS AND YOUTH AGAINST THE PRIMARY DEMANDS OF PATRIOTIC RESPONSIBILITY FOR PEOPLES, POLAND."

THE PAPER GAVE A LIST OF NAMES SUCH AS "BLUMSTEIN" AND "RUBENSTEIN" AND SAID "THESE PEOPLE .... WANTED TO DISTURB LINKS BETWEEN THE COMMUNITY AND THE PEOPLES, AUTHORITY."

TRYBUNA LUDU QUOTED THE HEALTH SERVICES AS SAYING 30 PERSONS WERE TREATED FOR INJURIES AND WO WERE IN HOSPITAL AFTER THE WEEKEND DEMONSTRATIONS. IN ADDITION, 28 UNIFORMED AND AUXILIARY POLICE WERE INJURED, THREE OF THEM SERIOUSLY.

UNITED PRESS SAID CLASSES WERE HELD AS NORMAL THIS MORNING BUT POLICE VANS WERE OUTSIDE THE UNIVERSITY AND PASSES OF PEOPLE ENTERING THE UNIVERSITY WERE BEING CHECKED BY PLAIN-CLOTHES POLICE.

IT ALSO CRITICISED UNIVERSITY AUTHORITIES WHO "FOR A LONG TIME PAID NO ATTENTION TO DISCIPLINE AND PROPER UPRBINGING OF YOUNG PEOPLE."

LEADERS OF THE DEMONSTRATIONS: "ADAM MICHNIK, JOZEF DEUTSCHGEWAND,  
ALEKSANDER SMOLAR, IRENA LASOTA, HENRYK SZLAJFER, EWA ZARZYCKA,  
KATARZYNA WERFEL, WIKTOR GORECKI, AND MIROSLAW SAWICKI.

THE NEWSPAPER DID NOT RPT NOT INDICATE WHAT IF ANY ACTION HAD  
BEEN TAKEN AGAINST ANY OF THAN.

WARSAW PRESS REPORTS SAID TODAY THAT WARSAW DISTRICT COURT SEN-  
TENCED THREE STUDENTS TO SIX MONTHS IMPRISONMENT AND ONE TO FOUR  
MONTHS UNDER A PENAL CODE ARTICLE DEALING WITH "PUBLICLY INSULTING  
AUTHORITY, GOVERNMENT OR THE ARMY." FIVE OTHERS WERE BEING  
DETAINED PENDING FURTHER INVESTIGATION.
