X/4/9 P - PAP SAYS POLITICALLY AMBITIOUS STUDENTS CREATED DISTURBANCE
(RELEADS CN - 12)

WARSAW, MARCH 9 (CMD) - THE POLISH NEWS AGENCY SAID TODAY THAT
YESTERDAY'S DISTURBANCES AT WARSAW UNIVERSITY WERE PROVOKED
BY "SMALL GROUPS OF UNBRIDLED AND MOSTLY WELL-TO-DO STUDENTS WITH
POLITICOS (SIC) AMBITIONS."

REPORTING ON WHAT IT CALLED "EXCESSES DISTURBING PUBLIC ORDER
AND THE NORMAL COURSE OF STUDIES," PAP SAID THE BEHAVIOUR OF THE
DEMONSTRATORS "DESERVES STERN CONDEMNATION."

IT SAID PUBLIC OPINION DEMANDED THAT STUDENTS RESPECT THEIR
PLEDGE TO OBSERVE UNIVERSITY REGULATIONS.

THE PAP ARTICLE WAS HEADLINED: "UNAUTHORIZED STUDENT MEETING." THE FULL TEXT FOLLOWS:

"EXCESSES DISTURBING PUBLIC ORDER AND THE NORMAL COURSE OF STUDIES TOOK PLACE ON MARCH 8TH AT THE WARSAW UNIVERSITY. A GROUP OF STUDENTS ATTEMPTED TO ORGANIZE IN THE COURT-YARD OF THE UNIVERSITY A MEETING WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE UNIVERSITY AUTHORITIES. THEY USED AS A PRETEXT FRO THE MEETING THE EXPULSION OF TWO STUDENTS WHO HAD BEEN NOTORIOUSLY ENGAGED FOR A COUPLE OF YEARS IN VARIOUS ANARCHISTIC POLITICAL ACTIONS AT THE WARSAW UNIVERSITY AND OUTSIDE OF IT. APART OF TH PARTICIPANTS IN THE DISTRUBANCE PROVOKED BRAWLS, RAISED HOSTILE CRIES AND VIOICED INSTULS AT THE ADDRESS OF REPRESENTATIVES OF WARSAW WORKERS AND A GROUP OF THE CITIZENS VOLUNTEER MILITIA WHO HAD ARRIVED IN CONNECTION WITH THE EXCESSES.

"ALL APPEALS MADE BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNIVERSITY AUTHORITIES, CALLING ON THE DEMONSTRATORS TO DISPERSE WERE OF NO AVAIL. A PART OF THE DEMONSTRATORS WHO HAD LATER COME OUT INTO THE STREET WERE JOINTED BY HOOLIGAN ELEMENTS OF VARIOUS TYPES.

"THE BEHAVVOUR OF THE PARTICIPANTS IN THE EXCESSES DESERVES STERN CONDEMNATION. THIS IS CERTAINLY THE OPINION OF THE OVERWHELMING MAJORITY OF WARSAW STUDENTS WHO WANT TO GAIN KNOWLEDGE AND HONESTLY TO FULFIL THEIR STUDENTS TASKS, AVAILING THEMSELVES OF THE CONDITIONS CREATED FOR THEM BY PEOPLES POLAND.

"THE REGRETTABLE EVENTS AT THE WARSAW UNIVERSITY WERE PROVOKED BY SAMLL GROUPS OF UNBRIDLED AND MOSTLY WELL-TO-DO TUDENTS WITH POLITICOS AMBITIONS. IT IS FITTING TO RECALL THE PLEDGE MADE UPON UNIVERSITY IMMATRICULATION, COMMITTING EVERY STUDENT TO A PROPER FULFILLMENT OF HIS OR HER DUTIES, TO THE OBSERVANCE OF DISCIPLINE AND OF THE RULINGS OF THE UNIVERSITY AUTHORITIES. PUBLIC OPINION, AND PARTICULARLY THE WORKERS CLASS WHICH CONTRIBUTES MOST TO THE COSTS OF THE EDUKATION OF YOUTH AND TO THE MAINTENANCE OF ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS, DEMAND FROM THE STUDENS THAT THIS PLEDGE BE KEPT."
